Mr. Henderson had commented that moving the sink unit in the library staff room would not be problematic and that floor-to-ceiling storage cupboard could be integrated into the Clerk's and Reception offices. Structural details included the potential requirement for a fire window in the Clerk's office and a new support

The Clerk would be asked to check the local government tendering process, should the costings be in excess of £25,000.

4230 To receive an update on the Neighbourhood Plan

Cllr. Kennedy reported that the draft survey report had been returned to Cheshire East for final amends. The poor quality of the draft supplied was noted. Further postcode analysis to divide Disley and Newtown and a realignment of questions for public presentation has been requested.

Cllr. Adams reported on a very productive meeting with Cheshire Community Action (CCA) and had high hopes for a good working partnership with CCA. She also noted that the central government grant from the Dept. for Communities and Local Government was now £9,000.

Cllr. Kennedy urged for fast progress on the public presentation and Cllr. Pattison suggested it could be combined with the Well-Dressing event in June.

Cllr. Adams reported that the Health Impact Assessment dates were now booked in with the Liverpool University students for early April. She also mentioned the successful meeting with Cllr. Sarah-Jane Gilmore from Poynton Neighbourhood Plan group.

Cllr. Adams and the Clerk would progress the Cheshire East funding application in w/c 28th March 2016.

Cllr. Pattison suggested that a public presentation could be given at the Disley School Fair
