Disley Parish - Notice of Meeting

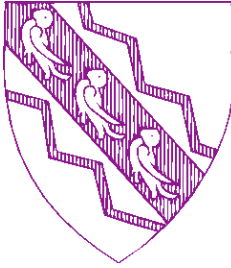
Notice is hereby given that the **ANNUAL PARISH MEETING** will be held at Disley Community Centre on Friday 26th April 2024 at 7.00pm.
