A meeting had been booked for w/c 16th April 2018 and it was agreed that the Parish Council would pursue a full consultation with options.

Davenport reported that he had met with Cheshire East Highways regarding potholes across the borough and that Highways were addressing the matter as a priority. Cllr. Adams said that central Government funding had been made available for this. Cllr. Davenport outlined details of the New Homes Bonus funding that was due to start shortly and that eligibility criteria were to be announced within the next few weeks. Cllr. Davenport had spoken to Tom Evans at Cheshire East regarding the outstanding Neighbourhood Plan grant and had been told that as the scheme had finished, it was unlikely to be received. Cllr. Davenport had asked Tom Evans to look at alternative funding sources. Cllr. Davenport said he was still chasing details of the A6/MARR Phase 2 mitigation budget. Cllr. Davenport reported that he had received a petition regarding the new bus stop in Newtown which he had
