

**MINUTES OF ORDINARY MEETING OF DISLEY PARISH COUNCIL
HELD ON WEDNESDAY 11TH APRIL 2018 AT DISLEY COMMUNITY CENTRE**

<u>Present:</u>	Cllrs. Pattison (Chairing), Adams, Chavasse-Hadfield, Davenport and Harrop. Start time: 7.30pm
6819	<u>To receive any Apologies for Absence.</u> Apologies received from Cllrs. Kidd and Kennedy.
6820	<u>To receive any declarations of disclosable pecuniary or non-pecuniary Interests.</u> None received.
6821	<u>Public Forum</u> Two residents requested an update on the proposed road closure on Hollinwood Road. Cllr. Pattison said that as this item was on the agenda, the meeting would discuss it then. Three representatives from Community Together addressed the meeting regarding a Community Grant Application. The representatives thanked the Parish Council for the £100 grant and free use of the Community Hall for their 2017 event and said they were looking to expand the event in 2018. In order to accommodate greater numbers, the event was being moved to Disley School. Costs included the school hire charges, public liability insurance, publicity and the expenses for the Women Asylum Seekers Together Choir. The group asked for a £200 grant to cover the hire cost, insurance and publicity. Cllr. Pattison responded that this item was due to be discussed by the Council as a separate agenda item.
6822	<u>To receive Chairman's Report</u> Cllr. Pattison informed the meeting that Cllr. Kennedy was currently unwell, and that Councillors had sent their best wishes to him.
6823	<u>To agree as a true and accurate record, the minutes of the Council Meeting held on 14th March 2018.</u> Proposed: Cllr. Adams Seconded: Cllr. Harrop Unanimously agreed
Resolved	<i>That the minutes of the Council Meeting held on 14th March 2018 are approved as a true and accurate record.</i>
6824	<u>To consider an application for a Disley Parish Council Community Grant received from Disley Community Together.</u> Cllr. Pattison reported that she had attended last year's Community Together event and confirmed that it had been very well attended and she understood the need to move to a larger venue. Cllr. Chavasse-Hadfield commented that the activities at the event had been very

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	<p>good. Cllr. Adams suggested that a small entrance fee could be used to offset some of the increased costs. Cllr. Harrop suggested a grant of £100 plus a contribution towards the hire of the school. Cllr. Davenport proposed a total grant of £150.</p> <p>Proposed: Cllr. Davenport Seconded: Cllr. Chavasse-Hadfield</p> <p>Unanimously agreed</p>
Resolved	<i>That a Disley Parish Council Community Grant of £150 be awarded to Disley Community Together towards the costs of an event on 8th July 2018.</i>
6825	<p>It was proposed to bring forward item 8.2 – Hollinwood Road traffic management, for the benefit of the residents in attendance.</p> <p>Proposed: Cllr. Adams Seconded: Cllr. Davenport</p> <p>Unanimously agreed</p>
Resolved	<i>That item 8.2 – Hollinwood Road traffic management, be brought forward for the benefit of the residents in attendance.</i>
6826	<p><u>Hollinwood Road traffic management – To note the proposed letter from Disley Parish Council to affected residents and receive an update from Cllr. Pattison.</u></p> <p>Cllr. Pattison updated the meeting that the Parish Council letter had not been distributed to residents on Hollinwood Road and environs. She highlighted that the letter could only be sent once Cheshire East Highways had committed to putting the proposed road closure on hold and conducting a consultation. Cllr. Davenport reported that he had received an assurance from Neil Jones at Highways that nothing would happen until he had met with Parish Councillors. A meeting had been booked for w/c 16th April 2018 and it was agreed that the Parish Council would pursue a full consultation with options.</p>
6827	<p><u>To receive the Cheshire East Councillors' Report</u></p> <p>Cllr. Davenport reported that he had met with Cheshire East Highways regarding potholes across the borough and that Highways were addressing the matter as a priority. Cllr. Adams said that central Government funding had been made available for this. Cllr. Davenport outlined details of the New Homes Bonus funding that was due to start shortly and that eligibility criteria were to be announced within the next few weeks. Cllr. Davenport had spoken to Tom Evans at Cheshire East regarding the outstanding Neighbourhood Plan grant and had been told that as the scheme had finished, it was unlikely to be received. Cllr. Davenport had asked Tom Evans to look at alternative funding sources. Cllr. Davenport said he was still chasing details of the A6/MARR Phase 2 mitigation budget. Cllr. Davenport reported that he had received a petition regarding the new bus stop in Newtown which he had</p>

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	<p>forwarded to Cheshire East. Cllr. Pattison commented that this bus stop should have been moved temporarily as reported by CE Highways. Cllr. Davenport agreed to chase this up with Highways. The Clerk confirmed that the petition had not been received directly by the Parish Council.</p>
6828	<p><u>To receive and consider Appendix D - the Disley Parish Council Projects List and associated reports.</u> <u>A6 Air Quality – To note the Disley Parish Council Air Quality Statement.</u> Cllr. Pattison recorded thanks to Cllr. Kidd for producing such a comprehensive statement. Cllr. Davenport reported that he had a meeting with Cheshire East shortly to discuss air quality mitigation. The Clerk confirmed that the Air Quality Statement was now on the Parish Council website.</p> <p align="right">Noted</p> <p><u>Neighbourhood Plan – To note Disley Parish Council’s response to initial questions raised by the independent examiner.</u> Cllr. Kidd had emailed an update that the examiner was being asked for a date extension in light of changes proposed to the Plan’s Housing Policy H1.</p> <p align="right">Noted</p>
6829	<p><u>To consider the Parish Council’s proposed adoption of Network Rail land to the rear of the Memorial Park on Buxton Road West.</u> Cllr. Pattison proposed that this item be deferred to the Council Meeting of 9th May 2018 as the Project Lead, Cllr. Kennedy, was not in attendance to provide updates.</p> <p align="right">Deferred</p>
6830	<p><u>To consider a report on traffic management issues on Buxton Old Road</u> Cllr. Pattison highlighted that the report had been produced in response to a resident letter and resident attendance at previous meetings regarding the issue. It was agreed that Buxton Old Road traffic management would be discussed at the forthcoming meeting with Neil Jones of Cheshire East Highways and that this item be deferred to the Council Meeting of 9th May 2018. Cllr. Pattison said that the gateways proposed for Buxton Old Road should be pursued.</p> <p align="right">Deferred</p>
6831	<p><u>To consider a report on electric vans in relation to Disley Parish Council’s Handyman Service vehicle.</u> Cllr. Harrop reported that he was not in favour of an electric vehicle but would support a hybrid vehicle. He outlined that the batteries used in electric vehicles were not environmentally friendly and the batteries needed replacing periodically. Cllr Harrop further commented that hybrids are cheaper to purchase and have better resale values. Cllr.</p>

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	<p>Davenport felt that given the newness of the technology, it was too earlier for the Parish Council to look at electric vehicles. It was proposed that the Parish Council would not pursue an electric vehicle for the Handyman Service but would consider other options and the budget at the next Council Meeting on 9th May 2018.</p> <p>Proposed: Cllr. Harrop Seconded: Cllr. Adams Unanimously agreed</p>

6832	<p><u>To note letter from Cheshire East regarding Local Plan Site Allocations and meetings with towns and parishes.</u></p> <p>Cllr. Pattison reported that Cllr. Kidd, Adams and Pattison were booked to attend a Site Allocations meeting on 8th May 2018. Councillors would report back at the next Council Meeting.</p> <p align="right">Noted</p>
6833	<p><u>To note a letter from Disley Primary School providing updates on the next phase of school growth.</u></p> <p>Cllr. Pattison welcomed the news regarding further investment in the school and said she would draft a letter of reply and thanks to the School Head and Head of Governors.</p> <p align="right">Noted</p>
6834	<p><u>To note an email from Cheshire East regarding proposals to charge for new or replacement bins.</u></p> <p>Cllr. Davenport reported that Cheshire East Council had received balanced feedback, for and against the proposals. The Clerk was requested to advertise the consultation in the next eBulletin and via Twitter and the website.</p> <p align="right">Noted</p>
6835	<p><u>To note a letter from Cheshire East Planning confirming the proposed Parish Council storage unit as a permitted development.</u></p> <p>Cllr. Davenport agreed to confirm if Building Regs. would be required for this project.</p> <p align="right">Noted</p>
6836	<p><u>To note an Electrical Installation Condition Report undertaken at the Community Centre.</u></p> <p align="right">Noted</p>

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6837	<p><u>To consider a response to a refreshed South East Manchester Multi Modal Strategy (SEMMMS) to 2040.</u> Cllr. Pattison reported that she had not been able to attend the recent SEMMMS drop-in session in Poynton but that the Parish Council had received a resident letter expressing dissatisfaction with the format. Cllr. Davenport had requested that the feasibility of a Disley by-pass be included in the strategy. Cllr. Pattison suggested that the Parish Council needed to comment on the strategy as a body and the matter should be deferred to the next Council Meeting on 9th May 2018.</p> <p align="right">Deferred</p>
